Changes to road layout in Aylsham

This notice is to update you on the changes that have been made to the roads in Aylsham, and to let you know what will be happening in the next few weeks.

In June changes were made to the roads in Aylsham in response to the government's guidance concerning the Covid-19 pandemic, and the need to allow people – particularly pedestrians – to move about freely and safely in high streets and shopping areas whilst maintaining social distancing.

In partnership with the Town Council, Broadland District Council will be making some further changes to the road layout in Aylsham.

The one way system in Red Lion Street will remain in place. By Friday, 4 September the barriers in Red Lion Street and the Market Place will be replaced by planters. This will enhance the look and feel of the area, and continue to provide space for social distancing.

There will be a further enforceable restriction placed on Oakfield Road to prevent it being used as a cut through, encouraging a diversion to be used.

Broadland District Council and Aylsham Town Council would like to thank you for your patience and cooperation over the past few months whilst the temporary changes have been in place.
