

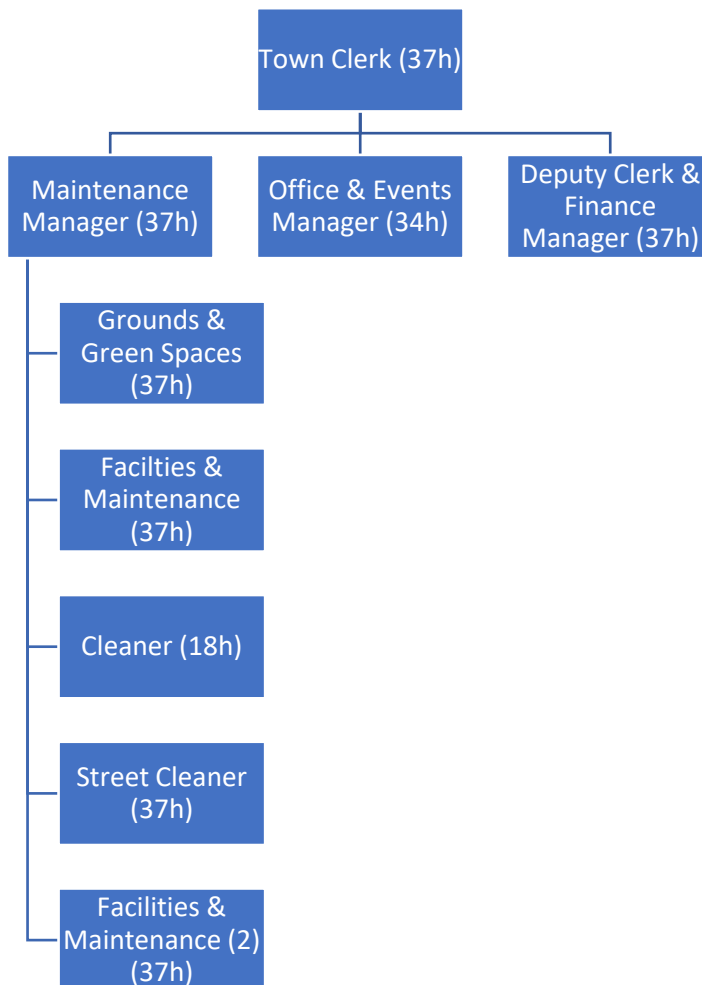


## About The Council

Aylsham Town Council consists of two teams that work together to provide public services to the residents of Aylsham and beyond. The councillors are all volunteers and are the decision making body. There are thirteen councillors and all are very proactive in the community and supportive of the staffing team.

- Mileham Drive play area and open space
- St Michael's play area and open space
- Wymer Drive play area
- Streetlighting
- Bus shelters
- An electric works van
