

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6313) affecting the White Hart Street from its junction with Cromer Road for 50m eastwards in the TOWN OF AYLSHAM to facilitate water connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 6th to 8th March 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Red Lion Street, Norwich Road, A140 Aylsham Bypass, Banningham Road, Drabblegate, Millgate, Gas House Hill, White Hart Street.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

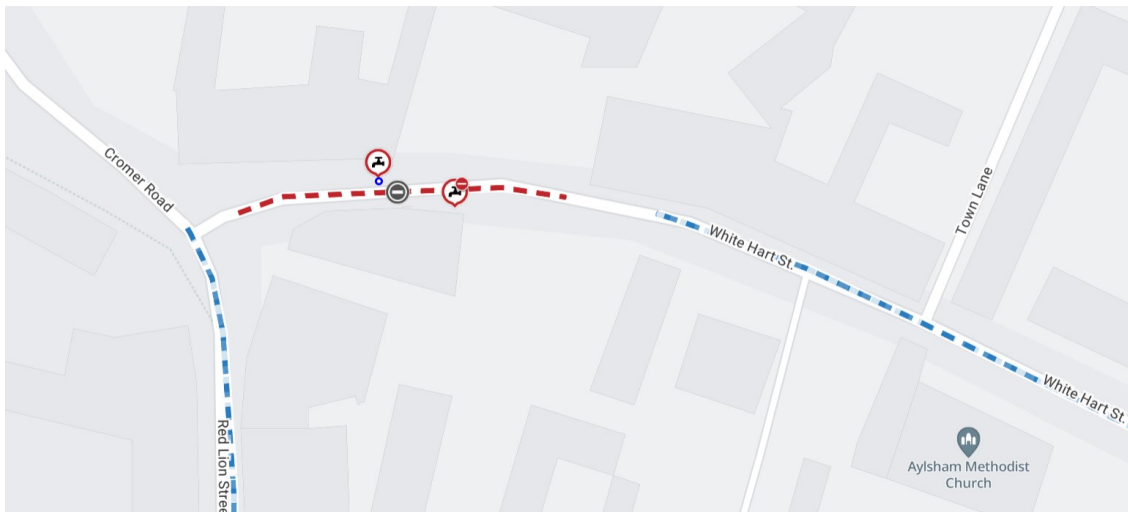
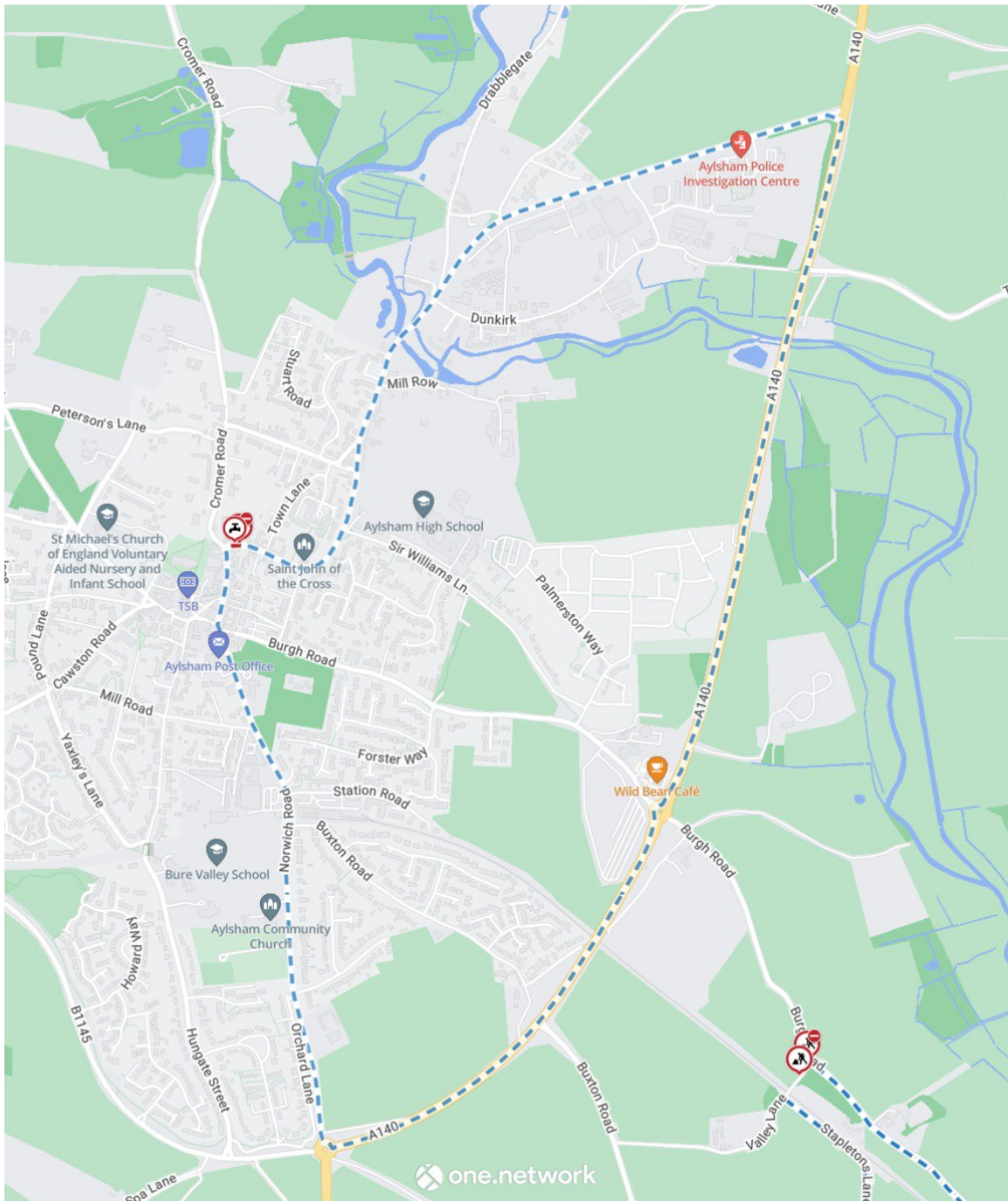
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
