NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7680) affecting the White Hart Street from its junction with Red Lion Street to its junction with Town Lane in the TOWN OF AYLSHAM to facilitate sewer works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 4th to 8th March 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Cromer Road, Bure Way, New Road, Millgate, Gashouse Hill, White Hart Street.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
